The Icelandic Swimming Association invites you to the 20<sup>th</sup> Reykjavík International Games - Swim Meet, January 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> 2024. The competition will take place in Laugardalslaug in Reykjavík in a 50m, 10-lane pool.

Many international swimmers have participated in the meet through the years, from Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Faroe Islands, Czech Republic, Germany, Slovakia, Qatar, USA, and the UK

Internationally experienced referees have been invited to conduct the technical part of the competition and it is a World Aquatics and LEN approved meet.

Participation in Reykjavík International Games also allows you to plan a training camp for your team before or after the competition. The Icelandic Swimming Association can help with booking training times and accommodation.

**Location:** Laugardalslaug swimming pool, Sundlaugarvegur 30, 105 Reykjavík, Iceland

**Competitors:** Reykjavík International Games is open to all swimmers.

**Rules:** The competition will be conducted under World Aquatics and IPC rules. The competition is approved as a qualifying event for the Olympics in Paris 2024 and has IPC Licence. Para swimmers seeded as per entry time.

**Entry deadline:** Deadline for preliminary entries is December 15<sup>th</sup> 2023  
Deadline for final confirmation of entries is January 10<sup>th</sup> 2024  
**Entries after deadlines are subject to availability and will be charged with late entry fee.**

**Qualifying Period:** January 1<sup>st</sup> 2023 to January 10<sup>th</sup> 2024.  
**Entry times must be achieved on long course or converted times from short course (see below)**

**Qualifying Times:** Swimmer qualified in one event will be given the opportunity to compete in up to two additional events, if space allows (total of up to three events).

**Awards** Medals for open and youth category. 3 best male and female swimmers will receive medals.  
In addition, winner of each event will receive EUR 50 in open category.

The five best overall performances according to the FINA point table will receive prize money as follows:

Best performance: EUR 1.000

2<sup>nd</sup> best performance: EUR 700

3<sup>rd</sup> best performance: EUR 400

4<sup>th</sup> best performance: EUR 200

5<sup>th</sup> best performance: EUR 100

**Entry fee**

EUR 9 or ISK 1200 per swimmer per event.  
Late entry fee is EUR 20 or ISK 3000 per swimmer per event  
Entry fee for entries in excel is EUR 12 or ISK 1800 per swimmer per event.  
The entry fee will not be returned under any circumstances.  
Entry fee must be paid no later than January 19<sup>th</sup> 2024, see bank details on following pages.

**Withdrawals:**

The competition office must be informed of withdrawals in writing.

Withdrawals from preliminary heats must be handed in at the latest 19:00 the day before.

Withdrawals from the finals must be handed in, no later than 30 minutes after completion of the heats' session.

Withdrawals can only be handed in on paper to an official in the competition office or by email to [meets@iceswim.is](mailto:meets@iceswim.is) Failure to hand in withdrawals within these time limits will be treated as DNS.

30 EUR or ISK 5000 in penalty fee for DNS during the competition. This will be invoiced to the club.

**Swim down pool**

During the competition, swimmers can use the outdoor 8 lane, 50m pool to swim down, as well as for warmup.

**Final call room**

15 minutes before the start of each race, competitors must appear in the final call room located behind the starting blocks and stay there until notified by officials to move to the pool deck. Entry to the final call room is only for competitors that are about to swim and officials.

**Victory ceremony:**

Victory ceremonies will be held in the prelims session for youth category and in the afternoon session for open category and will be announced in the meet program and by the competition office. Swimmers must report to the final call room before the victory ceremony in their team uniform. Failure to show up for the victory ceremony will result in a fine of EUR 8 or ISK 1200, invoiced to the club.

**Technical meeting:**

Technical meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 24<sup>th</sup> 2024 at 12:00 noon GMT on Microsoft Teams meeting. Any changes to the meet program and other important information will be announced there. Team contact persons will receive the invitation to the meeting.

## REGULATIONS

1. Reykjavik International Games – swimming competition, is held according to World Aquatics rules. The organizer is the Icelandic Swimming Association.
2. The competition takes place in an indoor Olympic pool (50m x 25m) and is being run on 8 lanes. Depth is 2m and water temperature is around 27°C.
3. The competition is open to all swimmers and the following age categories apply:

Age categories	Youth	Senior
Male	2009 and younger	2008 and older
Female	2010 and younger	2009 and older

4. Heats will be seeded according to the entry times, without any regards to the swimmers age. We only accept long course times or converted times. Convert times from short course (25m) to long Course (50m) by adding 2% to the entry time from short course.  
We only accept times equal to or faster than the standard time which is on the meet program.
5. Heats and finals will be swum in all 50m, 100m, and 200m events. Direct finals will be swum for the 800m and 1500m freestyle events. The 16 fastest swimmers (male and female) of each category from the heats will qualify for the A and B final in 50m and 100m events. For the 200m and 400m events only one heat of 8 swimmers will be swum in the finals.

6. The competition office must be informed of withdrawals in writing.  
Withdrawals from preliminary heats must be handed in at the latest 19:00 the day before.  
Withdrawals from the finals must be handed in no later than 30 minutes after completion of the heats.  
Withdrawals can only be handed in on paper to an official in the competition office or by email to [meets@iceswim.is](mailto:meets@iceswim.is) Failure to hand in withdrawals within these time limits will be treated as DNS.  
30 EUR or ISK 5000 in penalty fee for DNS during the competition. This will be invoiced to the club.
7. Medals for open category will be awarded in the finals session. 3 best male and female swimmers will receive medals. Medals for youth category will be awarded in the prelims sessions for 3 best boys and girls.

8. Special prizes will be awarded for the five best performances of the meet according to the latest World Aquatics point table as described above. Special gift will be awarded for the best performances for boys and girls in youth category according to the latest World Aquatics point table.
  
9. **Preliminary entries must be received by December 15<sup>th</sup> 2023.**  
**Final confirmation of entries must be received by January 10<sup>th</sup> 2024.** Only Splash and WinGrodan entry forms (via Swimrankings or email) can be used to register swimmers. Excel forms should be used where this is not available and is subject to higher entry fee, see below.  
Late entry fee is paid when deadlines are not met.

Entries on Excel forms are subject to entry fee of EUR 12 or ISK 1800 per swimmer per event.  
**Late entry fee is EUR 20 or ISK 3000** for each individual event.
